Program Structure

Each jurisdiction provides an Earth Smart Actions entry webpage link to its residents. Residents engage with the content at no cost to them, choosing from a menu of activities that can be safely accomplished at their homes and around their neighborhoods. The activities generate reportable data about environmental accomplishments that can be meaningful to cities for outreach and future planning.

Activities are suited to users of all ages and abilities and include such actions as:

- Understanding common neighborhood pollutants and their impact in the environment
- How stormwater flows from homes to major waterways
- Neighborhood actions that improve water quality
